

Dried Orange garland recipe

Ingredients:

Twine

2-3 large oranges (depending on the twine length)

Needle (optional)

Preheat the oven to 200°F

slice 2-3 large oranges into 1/2 inch thick slices.

Put slices onto a baking sheet covered with parchment paper.

Bake for 2-3 hours or until golden brown and dried, flipping the slices occasionally throughout the cooking process (cooking time may vary).

Let the orange slices dry overnight. Thread twine through the center of each orange slice until the line of twine is filled up.

Hang anywhere around the home for good vibes and festivity!


